### MEETING OF THE ASSOCIATION COUNCIL.

### Saturday, 9th August, 2014, after BTC Regatta.

There will be a Meeting of the Association Council on Saturday, 9th August, 2014 after BTC Regatta, at a location to be advised – but probably near the refreshment tent, with reference to the Associations Constitution - Rules (7) and (12)(see over). The meeting will be held immediately before or after the prize giving depending on the circumstances - an announcement will be made over the PA system.

The Agenda for the meeting is as follows:-

- 1) To confirm the Associations Champions in each status and to make arrangements for a "row-off" if applicable.
- 2) To considor if the Association will enter 3<sup>rd</sup> crews in Championship events if SCC Rule 25 (B) invoked (see
- 3) To agree the Associations representative Crews for the South Coast Championship Regatta to be held at Swanage, Dorset, on Saturday, 13th September, 2014 and to make arrangements for any "row-offs" that may be required.
- 4) Any Other Business submitted in accordance with Association Rules.

Voting rights at the council meeting are the Associations Executive Officers, the Associations Life Vice Presidents plus one delegates from each affiliated Club and one delegate from each affiliated Event(H&D Constitution Rules number (7/7.1). Officers and delegates must be in attendance to vote and the vote will be by card - which will be issued at or before the meeting.

<u>Alternative arrangements if BTC Regatta is cancelled or abandoned.</u>

- 1) If the BTC Regatta is abandoned after the start of the Regatta the Council meeting will take place at the Regatta as soon as practical - the time will be announced over the PA System at the Regatta.
- 2) If the Regatta is cancelled the day before the Regatta due to the forcast, or on the morning of the Regatta, but before it starts, the meeting will take place at BTC Rowing Club at 1.00pm on Saturday, 9th August. PLEASE MAKE SURE YOUR DELEGATES ARE AWARE OF THESE ALTERNATIVE ARRANGEMENTS.

### **Annual General Meeting.**

The Associations Annual General Meeting was held on Saturday, 22nd March, 2014 - and while the minutes have been available to download from the Web site for some time I am now circulating a hard copy for your information. Please keep hold of this copy as, in order to save time, printing and postage I do not intend to circulate these again for the next AGM – although they can be downloaded from the web site at any time.

### Entry Information, Entry Fees, The Web Site – www.hdara.co.uk. and "Twitter".

Every season a number of Clubs contact me because they have not received event invitations or notification of when entries close – and I have to provide them with this information, assuming I have received it as Association Secretary, which is not always the case. There is a growing trend for Event Secretaries to either hand out invitations at an earlier event – or just to send them by E Mail. In both cases they sometimes fail to reach the right person. Event Secretaries should take a "belt and braces" approach - and back-up an E Mail



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invitation with a hard copy in the post. The other source of information Clubs should be aware of the is the Hants & Dorset ARA Web Site - www.hdara.co.uk - when (if) I receive the regatta information I usually add this to the H&D Calendar, which is on the home page of the Web site. I also add the date entries close as a separate calendar entry. If you click on either - you should get additional information - the invitation - which can also usually be downloaded in pdf. Format. Where possible the draw and program are also added and available to download when known. I will usually put a statement in the "latest information" section, on the left-hand side of the home page – when an item is added to the Calendar and this is also usually sent out as a "tweet" – so if you have a "twitter" account – follow @hdara and you should receive these notifications.

### 2014 Swanage Regatta – Saturday, 21st June. A Big Thank You.
