The Hants & Dorset Amateur Rowing Association as hosts and in accordance with SCC Rules advised the Council at its January in 2023 AGM of our proposed venue and date for the 2024 Championship event

Following the success of the 2021 South Coast Championships at Netley, near Southampton the Association decided to return to Royal Victoria Country Park, Netley for the 2024 Event.

DATES & BOATS

- The Rules of the South Coast Council (SCC Rule 36) states that The Championship Regatta WILL be advertised to be held NO LATER than the second week in September.
- The two dates available to the Association are Saturday, 7th or 14th September 2024.
- Due to tidal constraints the Association has decided that SATURDAY, 14th SEPTEMBER 2024 is the most suitable date.
- As a Coastal Association The Championship and Open Events will be raced in Coxed Coastal Fours. (SCC Rule 11).
- The Junior Events will be raced in Coxed Coastal Quads.

 The date of a South Coast Championships Regatta at Netley/Victoria Country Park, Southampton will be Saturday, 14th September 2024.



- Course last used for the Championships in 2021.
- Facilities are excellent and provisional discussions have taken place with stake holders and some costings established.
- The course for the Championship and Open Events would be 1800m and 1000m for the Junior Events.
- The Venue would allow all Championship, Open and Junior Events to take place.





- The alternative course at Dock Head, Southampton is not available in 2024 (SCC Rule 19).
- There will be no alternative course available. If required, the Organising Committee will endeavour to run Championship Events only on the Netley Course on Sunday 15th September 2024.




ACCOMMODATION, PARKING, RECEPTION, PRIZE GIVING & REGATTA PARTY.

The COURSE & OFFICIALS

- The Championship/Open Events 1800m
- The Junior Events 1000m.
- The Start Umpires will be afloat in two 8m ribs and will follow the races from start to finish.
 - The Start and Finish lines will have fixed poles on the beach.
 - The Start Boat (Mary Siobhan) will be on the outside of the course
 - Lane No1 will be on the outside with lane No 6 closest to the shore (SCC Rule 11a)
 - There will be a buoyed Transit Lane on the inside of the course for crews progressing to the Start.
 - The outside of the course will be marked by a series of yellow buoys plus an orange inflatable buoy/s behind the Start line.
 - The Officials will go afloat from a small slipway at Netley Sailing Club and may involve a boat to boat transfer.

Safety
